

FY 2011 State, Foreign Operations and Related Programs

Center for Hemispheric Policy, \$750,000

University Of Miami, Center For Hemispheric Policy, Miami-Dade County, Florida

Funds will be used for a project titled "Globalization's Impact on Democracy and Market Economies in the Hemisphere and the Implications for U.S. Policy." The projects assigns a task force on globalization's impact on democracy and market economies in the Hemisphere, a task force on U.S. policy toward Latin America in the new multi-polar world, a Resident Fellow Program, a Visiting Fellow Program, an Annual Latin America Conference and Leadership Symposiums.

University of Miami's Global Institute Haiti Relief Project, \$5,000,000

University Of Miami's Miller School Of Medicine, Miami-Dade County, Florida

Funds will be directed toward a 300 bed field hospital, University of Miami Haiti Hospital (UMHH), which will transition to a full-fledged Haitian trauma network and 250 bed rehabilitation hospital over the next year. Additionally, the University has trained Haitian physicians to be family doctors in Cap Haitian. This program served approximately 100,000 patients last year. As a result of the recent earthquake, demand has increased for these programs. The funding will assist in the transition of the current field hospital into a permanent trauma network and rehabilitation hospital, allowing progress in the Central Plateau and Cap Haitian to continue, while absorbing increased demand.
