A Virtual Incubator for Improving the Quality of Early Learning Services - Five Year Initiative, \$300,000

University Of North Florida, Duval County, Florida

Funds will be used to design and field test tools and strategies needed to accelerate the quality, growth and success rates of early learning outcomes for young children, particularly for those living in low-income neighborhoods.

Aerospace Workforce Transition Initiative, \$5,000,000

Brevard Workforce Development Board, Brevard County, Florida

Funds will be used to train aerospace workers affected by the Shuttle retirement and help them transition into emerging and high demand industries.

Art of the Olympians Wellness Program, \$100,000

Art Of The Olympians, Lee County, Florida

Funds will support Art of the Olympians outreach and education to underserved youth and their families as it related to nutrition and fitness.

Baker County Health Department Expansion, \$2,000,000

Baker County Health Department, Baker County, Florida

Funds will be used to expand the existing medical area of the Baker County Health Department.

BayCare Health Systems Expanded Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder Initiative, \$250,000

BayCare Health System, Pinellas County, Florida

Funds will be used to for an integrated program that will embrace individuals afflicted with Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) and their families to provide critically needed services to help victims become holistic for mental health, social, and industrial activity.

Bethesda West Hospital Community Telemedicine Initiative, \$250,000

Bethesda Healthcare System & Bethesda West Hospital, Palm Beach County, Florida

Funds will be used for computer hardware and software planning, logistics, and the evaluation of technology to enhance collaboration among healthcare providers and subspecialists.

Bob Graham Center for Public Service, \$5,000,000

Bob Graham Center for Public Service, Alachua County, Florida

Funds will be used to archive the papers of former Senator and Governor Bob Graham and also to train students to be engaged citizens.

Breast Cancer Early Detection Community Based Outreach Program, \$200,000

Florida Breast Health Initiative, Miami-Dade County, Florida

Funds will be used to bring early detection resources and free mammograms to an additional 20,000 households in underserved neighborhoods within South Florida.

Building Strong Families Homeless Prevention, \$250,000

Jewish Family And Children's Service Of Sarasota-Manatee, Sarasota County, Florida

Funds will be used for direct care integrated homeless prevention case management, vocational services including assistance with employment skill and placement, outreach and evaluation staff, immediate cash assistance to avoid homelessness, required office equipment transportation and indirect administrative costs.

Funds will be used to deliver a coordinated outreach and intervention initiative to improve the outcomes of those with blood cancer.

Funds will be used to develop a web-based tool to help doctors formulate cancer treatment approaches that are informed by the latest research and personalized to the specific needs of each individual patient.

Community Health Network, \$850,000

Parrish Medical Center, Brevard County, Florida

Funds will be used to expand the Community Health Network (CHN) to include diabetes education, as well as a clinical education program.

Construction of the Holocaust Documentation and Education Center and Museum, \$1,500,000

Holocaust Documentation And Education Center, Broward County, Florida

Funds will be used for the construction of the Holocaust Documentation and Education Center and Museum which is the first Holocaust Center in South Florida and the first in North America to tell the story in English and Spanish.

Cyber Security NASA Retraining Initiative, \$500,000

Funds will be used to train former NASA workers in cyber security. Many NASA scientists, engineers, and technicians have transferable skills in the field of cyber-security.

Funds will be used for the acquisition of updated MRI and Fluoroscopic equipment to meet physician requirements and the associated facility renovation to house this new technology equipment (the New Generation Radiology Project).

Funds will be used to advance the completion of the Northeast Center at Polk State College.

Electronic Health Record Implementation, \$500,000

Funds will be used to develop an electronic health record system for the 462-bed nursing home.

Equipment Upgrade Program, \$475,000

Helen B. Bentley Family Health Center, Miami-Dade County, Florida

Funds will be used to help the Helen B. Bentley Family Health Center expand and improve its service to the low-income community in the State.

Expansion of Electronic Medical Records, \$1,000,000

University Community Hospital, Hillsborough County, Florida

Funds will be used to implement a physician portal that would pull information from a multitude of systems into one view.

Fire Engineer Training Simulator, \$100,000

Funds will be used to purchase a Fire Engineer Training Simulator to provide state-of-the-art, hands-on training experience for Fire Engineers that attend the Coral Springs Fire Academy.

Florida Civic Leadership Academy, \$290,000

Funds will be used to provide Florida high school teachers with opportunities to learn about Florida state and local government through summer internships in their communities.

Florida Gulf Coast University (FGCU) Health Professions Building, \$500,000

Funds will be used to enhance the 64,000 sf. Health Professions building at FGCU. The primary goals are to meet the educational needs of students interested in health professions and to address the critical shortage of health care professionals in Florida.

Funds will be used to train and place up to 750 Floridians from the underserved populations including the unemployed, underemployed, Veterans, Welfare recipients, and Youth would be trained and placed in existing entry-level manufacturing jobs.

Funds will be used to dramatically increase jobs and job training for previously incarcerated individuals through a highly acclaimed prisoner re-entry program called Ready4Work.

Funds will be used to replace a generator that is 27 years old.

Graduate Registered Nurse (RN) Training Program, \$1,500,000

Health First Electronic Intensive Care Unit Initiative, \$350,000

Health First, Brevard County, Florida

Funds will be used to purchase an additional 26 e-care mobile units to provide adequate coverage in Health First hospitals and other regional hospitals.

Health Informatics Curriculum Development and Technology, \$100,000

Miami Dade College, Miami-Dade County, Florida

Federal funds will be used to assist in the development of a new certificate program in health informatics in response to anticipated shortages in trained informatics professionals as a result of the government's financial commitment to modernizing health care.

Healthy Beginnings Database and System Evaluation, \$175,000

Children Services Council Of Palm Beach County, Palm Beach County, Florida

Funds will be used to provide seamless, efficient and accountable delivery of prevention and early intervention services to Palm Beach County through a new database system.

Imaging Technology Upgrade, \$1,000,000

Wolfson Children's Hospital, Duval County, Florida

Funds will be used to purchase a 3 Tesla (3T) MRI for Wolfson Children's Hospital. The 3T offers contrast advantages that vastly improve angiographic, stroke, and metabolic testing.

Information and Communication Technology Upgrade, \$290,000

Monroe County School District, Monroe County, Florida

Funds will be used to replace approximately 615 laptops and tablet PCs for teachers.

Institute for Collaborative Sciences Research, \$1,800,000

Barry University, Miami-Dade County, Florida

Funds will be used to establish, enhance, and expand Barry University's research capabilities and academic opportunities for minority students in its undergraduate programs.

Jefferson County Public Gym and Fitness Program, \$100,000

Jefferson County Board Of County Commissioners, Jefferson County, Florida

Funds will be used to revitalize an abandoned high school gymnasium in central Monticello, equipping it for community activities.

Joe DiMaggio Children's Hospital Expansion Project, \$500,000

Memorial Healthcare System, Broward County, Florida

Funds will be used to equipment for the new Pediatric Oncology Unit being built as part of the expansion of Joe DiMaggio Children's Hospital.

Joe. K and Alberta Blanton Nursing Building Expansion, \$350,000

Florida Southern College, Polk County, Florida

Funds will be used to allow Florida Southern College to expand the Joe K. and Alberta Blanton Nursing Building to add a much needed classroom and an additional nursing skills laboratory to the existing facility which opened in 2009 and has already reached enrollment capacity.

Funds will be used to establish an innovative clinical trial research facility in the new hospital adjacent to the Florida Center for Innovation.

Funds will be used to renovate a 21,000 square foot facility to provide physical, mental and emotional health services to children in Devereux's residential program and area foster care programs.

Funds will be used for facilities and equipment, including a new six story inpatient pavilion, renovation of the operating room complex, and the conversion of approximately 53 medical/surgical beds to private rooms.

Funds will be used to develop a social services campus with support operations to serve hungry, homeless, unemployed/ underemployed families in need in Brevard County.

Funds will be used for facilities and equipment for Camillus House's new behavioral health facility for the homeless.

Funds will be used for the installation of two new Critical Care Monitoring Systems for the neurosurgical intensive care and critical care units at Holy Cross Hospital.

Funds will be used to expand Florida SUMS, which is a comprehensive professional development program for elementary teachers and principals.

Substance Abuse and Mental Health Programs, \$500,000

Community Rehabilitation Center, Inc., Duval County, Florida

Funds will be used to continue long-term substance abuse prevention and mental health programs for individuals with severe mental health ailments.

Swisher Memorial Library Improvement Project, \$750,000

Funds will be used to upgrade existing technological infrastructure and reconfigure the interior to include a master reading room, a curriculum laboratory, two instructional technology laboratories, private study areas and small conference rooms to accommodate collaborative learning.

Funds will be used to continue the Community Health Centers program, which is a community-run health care delivery system that is open to all, regardless of their ability to pay.

United Way Center for Excellence in Early Education, \$250,000

United Way Of Miami Dade, Miami-Dade County, Florida

Funds will be used to provide high quality early education to multicultural children from low income families and continuous training for parents, which will be designed to enhance their parenting and teaching skills, and increase their understanding of the nutritional needs of infants, toddlers and pre-school age children.

Women's Center/Post-Partum Unit at Broward General Medical Center, \$5,000,000

Broward Health, Broward County, Florida

Funds will be used to develop a 36-bed, 28,000 square foot, state of the art unit that will allow the mother, baby, and family to engage post delivery.

Youth Ranches Job Training Program, \$950,000

Florida Sheriff's Youth Ranches, Suwannee County, Florida

Funds will be used to provide thirteen weeks of intense job training for at risk, foster care youth who are aging out the system. The program will provide fast tracked GED prep (80% success rate), vocational skills in welding, pipefitting, plumbing, linemen, culinary arts, heavy equipment operators, etc.
